Post Graduate Institute of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (PGIVAS) was established in the year 1970 under administrative and financial control of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Krishi Vidyapeeth (Dr. PDKV), Akola, running Post Graduate Programmes in eleven well equipped Departments. Consequent upon the establishment of Maharashtra Animal & Fishery Sciences University (MAFSU) at Nagpur, in the year 2000, these departments were metamorphosed and started functioning as an independent constituent Institute of newly formed Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur, renamed as Post Graduate Institute of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Akola (PGIVAS).

Participation

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

Abstract of individual case studies/ clinical case reports (during last one year) under discipline of Veterinary Clinical Medicine; Surgery and Radiology; Animal Reproduction Gynaecology and Obstetrics are invited for presentation. Abstracts duly certified by the respective Head of the Department/ Associate Dean will be only accepted. Clinical studies on group of animals will not considered. Abstract

should be well organized, should not exceed 350 words and should be in Times New Roman, font size 12 with 1.5 line spacing in editable MS Word format. Abstract title should be given in upper case in bold letters. Only the presenting student author(s) name, name of faculty advisor(s) affiliation, address with email ID should be mentioned below the title of the abstract.

Scientific committee will review the abstracts. Each student is eligible to present only one paper out of the abstract he had submitted. The abstract submitted should not have been presented/ published elsewhere. All accepted abstracts will be included in the compendium. **Abstracts should be submitted on or before 1st February, 2018.**

Guidelines for Presentation

Each participant will be provided five minutes for presentation followed by a three minute discussion. Presentation has to be done in MS power point format.

It is mandatory that participants have a copy of their presentation in a virus free removable disk /pen drive which is to be loaded well in advance prior to the session.

Travel and Accommodation

Participants are requested to make their own arrangements for travel and accommodation. Accommodation on paid basis can be arranged if informed well in advance.
